One of the biggest events that the York Jaycees participates in is Holiday Hope (formerly Hide the Line). Anyone that has ever helped and participated in this event can tell you it is not only fun, but also extremely rewarding. **Hide the Line starts off with several fundraisers to acquire** funds to use for this event. First, throughout the holiday season we will place donation cans at local businesses. We also solicit customers for donations at the East York K-Mart for 2 weekends starting Black Friday. Additionally this year, we will be asking for donations from freezing shoppers standing in Black Friday lines in exchange for coffee, hot chocolate, and snacks. The Jaycees asks local organizations to choose deserving families to participate. On the morning of December 11<sup>th</sup> Jaycees will then take each child from each family shopping for clothing and other winter items. Parents are invited to assist with the shopping. After the shopping, there will be a holiday breakfast for the families and Jaycees. Santa will make an appearance and give each child a new toy. Each family will receive a gift basket filled with non-perishable items for the holiday. Please find a few minutes of your time this busy holiday season to help make a child smile!

During the month of January we will again be teaming up with York's Helping Hands to help with their program Feeding York. Jaycees will provide hot meals and bagged lunches to needy community members. We will contribute funds toward the food runs, and will request donations from area merchants to offset as much of the cost as possible. Finally, we will be determining recipients of the financial contributions for this year and who to partner up with next year. Applications for financial grants are received, and then voted upon by the membership.
